Mugshots "JOINTS: the photography of Laura Kicey & Dustin Fenstermacher" Opening, Philadelphia PA

Laura Kicey and Dustin Fenstermacher will exhibit photographs in their show "Joints: the photography of Laura Kicey & Dustin Fenstermacher" at Mugshots Coffeeshop and Café, 2100 Fairmount Ave, Philadelphia. from February 4 thru March 4, 2007. The show will open with a reception on Thursday, February 8 from 6:30 pm to 8.30 pm. Mugshots will provide light fare for guests.

The photographs will be presented as pairs, literally a nd metaphorically mirroring the travels of the two photographers who have been exploring the Mid Atlantic region together for over a year. Each photo, though distinctive in its storytelling, tells a richer story with its partner, as each of the photographers drew inspiration from the other's work and presence on their travels. The images explore common themes related in uncommon ways, seeking to draw distinctions and similarities between the two artists' visions.

Mr. Fenstermacher's work has appeared in FILE Magazine, Utata, JPG magazine, and on a recent cover of Picture Business Magazine. He currently works as a photographer with Wonderful Machine in Newtown Square, PA. His work is a part of a number of private collections and was recently shown in Yards Brewery's display of photos from the Divine Lorraine Hotel. Fenstermacher holds an undergraduate degree in Journalism and Communications from Shippensburg University.

Ms. Kicey's had her first solo show at a recent 'Art in the Storefront' display in Ambler, PA. Her work was recently published in two books by Catherine Jamieson, 'Create Your Own Photoblog' and 'Digital Portrait Photography and Lighting'. Her work has appeared in FILE magazine, Phillylist, JPG magazine, Utata and was featured in Picture Business magazine with an accompanying interview. Her work has been shown at the Nexus and Muse Galleries in Philadelphia and is a part of a number of private collections. Kicey holds an undergraduate degree in Communication Design from Kutztown University. She is a graphic designer at Marcolina Design Inc. in Ambler.
